1 - MOST GARAGE CABINETS ARE NOT DESIGNED TO MOVE!



Many companies use staples and melamine wood to secure their cabinets to the walls of your garage - permanently!

The cabinets themselves are often stapled together, meaning they will crack and break if you try to disassemble them.

So, when you sell your home, your cabinets get left behind...

Bigfoot Garage Cabinets are built using a boltless metal frame and strong wooden panels that can be quickly and easily dismantled with a rubber mallet.

2 - MANY GARAGE CABINETS HAVE TERRIBLE SHELVES!



Many cabinets support their shelves with weak, plastic hardware.

This not only limits how much weight these shelves can support, but it also leads to warping and long-term damage.

Don't get stuck with cabinets that deteriorate over time!

Bigfoot Garage Cabinets use a heavy-duty metal frame to support the entire shelf!

This allows you to store heavy items and ensures that the cabinets and shelves will stand the test of time!





3 - MOST GARAGE CABINETS CANNOT BE CLEANED UNDERNEATH

Most companies build their garage cabinets straight into the wall of your garage and they end up sitting directly on your garage floor.

This means that when cleaning your garage floor or you have a small flood, they are likely to get wet. This damages cabinets by causing the wood to expand and swell up, which looks horrible!

4 - TRADITIONAL GARAGE CABINETS HAVE WALLS INSIDE
