


# 5 Things You Need to Know When Buying Garage Cabinets


## Not all garage cabinets are created equal



### \* Cannot Be Cleaned underneath:

Most garage cabinets are built off of your stem wall as pictured and the melamine wood is in contact with the cement floor. If by chance you get them wet by cleaning your garage floor, or you have a small flood in the garage it will cause the melamine wood to expand not good. The wood will swell up and look horrible.

**Bigfoot Garage Cabinets** are designed to be cleaned underneath. We leave you six-inches of clearance so you'll be able to safely clean your garage floor without risking damaging your cabinets.



### \* Low Shelf Weight Limit:

As picture, you can see how many garage cabinets support their shelves. With little plastic pins or metal tracks not really giving proper shelf support.

**Bigfoot Garage Cabinets** have a metal frame which supports the shelves for maximum weight capacity of up to 600 pounds per shelf. [As pictured on the right]



### \* Cannot Be Disassembled to Take with You:

Many garage cabinets are not designed to move. They use staples and melamine wood to secure them to the walls of your garage. And the cabinets themselves are stapled together. Melamine wood is not meant to be disassembled and will crack and break when doing so. Which means when you sell your house you sell your garage cabinets.

**Bigfoot Garage Cabinets** can easily be disassembled and move that's the way they were design. The foundation for the garage cabinet is a boltless racking system which could be easily dismantled.

Using high quality melamine wood we mounting them on to our metal foundation are cabinets are easily dismantled and having very minimal parts to them. Heck all you need is a Ziploc sandwich bag and you'll be able to safely store all the nuts and bolts and washers for the cabinet. Your rack disassembles quickly with a rubber mallet and your wood panels can easily be moved around with one person.



### \* Traditional Garage Cabinets Need Room for the Doors to Open:

Traditional garage cabinets with swinging hinged doors need about 2 feet for the doors to fully open. If you're car is parked next to it it can be a tight fit getting to your stuff or you may actually have to move the car.
